OVERVIEW

Generosity without stewardship is irresponsible. Stewardship without generosity is selfish. God's heart is that we grow to become a generous giver and a wise steward because what we do with our money is evidence of what's most important to us. Many times, we give money in response to a felt need or in response to a tragedy—it's emotional and the results are measurable. But in addition to that, what would it look like to become someone who was not only an intervention giver, but a prevention giver.
