ETHOS

MONDAY

UNITY WITHIN ETHOS

That we would be one family, valuing and embracing one another. Unified around the vision and mission God has given our community.

// John 17:20-21 - My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

HEALTHY, LIFE-GIVING COMMUNITY

To be a church that lives life together, as a family.

// Hebrews 10:24-25 - Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

TUESDAY

BUILDING FOR ALL PEOPLE

For wisdom and provision to plant roots deeper in the community and to build for the community. For the multipurpose facility to be a home of Ethos and create space for all people.

// Ephesians 3:20 - Now all glory to God, who is able, through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think.

// Matthew 16:18 - I will build my church, and the gates of Hades[b] will not overcome it.

ETHOS CARE CENTER

Expanding our network of care and services to further meet the practical needs in our city.

// Luke 4:18-19 - "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.

WEDNESDAY

KIDS

That kids will grow close to God and know Him personally.

// Colossians 1:9-10 - Pray that you're filled with the knowledge of His will and have a walk fully pleasing to Him.

YTH (grades 6th-12th)

For students to embrace their identity in Jesus and ability to impact the world.

// 1 Timothy 4:12 - Don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity.

YOUNG ADULTS

That college aged and young adults would remain committed to their faith in Jesus and follow him closely in community.

// Ephesians 3:17 - Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong.

THURSDAY

TO BE DISCIPLES WHO MAKE DISCIPLES

That we would be intentional to share our faith and build up others faith in Jesus.

// 2 Timothy 2:2 - You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others.

BUILDING BRIDGES BETWEEN GENERATIONS

That we would invest into and learn from every generation. Increased spiritual fathers and mothers in our church.

// Psalm 71:18 - So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim your might to another generation, your power to all those to come.

FRIDAY

FAITH

That God would increase my expectations and beliefs in what He wants to do in and through my life.

// Ephesians 3:20 - Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.

// Hebrews 11:1 - Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

RELIANCE ON GOD

For increased trust in God's plan and wisdom in every season of life for both myself and for my church family.

// 2 Corinthians 4:15 - Every detail works to your advantage and to God's glory: more and more grace, more and more people, more and more praise!

MY FAMILY / HOUSEHOLD

That my household (family, spouse, roommates) would be focused on following Jesus together.

// Joshua 24:15 - As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.

SATURDAY

SALVATIONS

For those who do not know Jesus, to come to know Him personally.

// Romans 10:10 - For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

SUNDAYS

For every person to encounter Jesus through the power of God's Word, life-giving worship, and the encouragement of gathering together in community.

// Psalm 100:2-3 - Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his: we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

SUNDAY

LOVING ALL PEOPLE IN JESUS' NAME

That Jesus' love for me would overflow to those I interact with each day.

// 1 John 3:16 - This is how we have discovered love's reality: Jesus sacrificed his life for us. Because of this great love, we should be willing to lay down our lives for one another.

FOLLOW JESUS

That I would daily be with Jesus, become like Jesus, and do the things Jesus did.

// John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
