- DAY 1 - CULTURE OF PRAYER**  
**That I'd pray about everything. For the Ethos family to be unified in prayer.**  
*// Phil. 4:6-7 Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank him for all He has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.*
- DAY 2 - UNITY WITHIN ETHOS**  
**That we would be one family, valuing & embracing one another, and unified around the vision & mission God has given our community.**  
*// John 17:20-21 My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.*
- DAY 3 - UNITY WITH OTHER CHURCHES**  
**Ask God to bring favor and wisdom to all life-giving churches in our city (praying over churches by name).**  
*// Rom. 12:4-5 For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.*
- DAY 4 - BUILDING BRIDGES BETWEEN GENERATIONS**  
**That we would invest into and learn from every generation. Increased spiritual fathers and mothers in our church.**  
*// Psalm 71:18 So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim your might to another generation, your power to all those to come.*
- DAY 5 - MENTAL HEALTH**  
**Freedom from anxiety and depression. Healing from hurt. Safety in community. Security in the peace of God.**  
*// John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.*
- DAY 6 - SERVE COLUMBUS**  
**Finding and meeting the needs in our city.**  
*// Luke 4:18-19 "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.*



### DAY 7 – FAITH

**That God would increase my expectations and beliefs in what He wants to do in and through my life.**

*// Eph. 3:20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us. // Heb. 11:1 Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.*



### DAY 8 – HEALTHY, LIFE-GIVING COMMUNITY

**To be a church that lives life together, as a family.**

*// Heb. 10:24-25 Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.*



### DAY 9 – MY FAMILY / HOUSEHOLD

**That my household (family, spouse, roommates) would be focused on following Jesus together.**

*// Joshua 24:15 As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.*



### DAY 10 – RELIANCE ON GOD

**For increased trust in God's plan and strength instead of my personality or talents.**

*// 2 Cor. 4:15 (MSG) Every detail works to your advantage and to God's glory: more and more grace, more and more people, more and more praise!*



### DAY 11 – PATIENCE

**That I would be a non-anxious presence, willing to wait for God and trust in His timing.**

*// Isaiah 40:31 But they who wait upon the Lord will get new strength. They will rise up with wings like eagles. They will run and not get tired. They will walk and not become weak.*



### DAY 12 – LOVING ALL PEOPLE IN JESUS' NAME

**That Jesus' love for me would overflow to those I interact with each day.**

*// 1 John 3:16 (TPT) This is how we have discovered love's reality: Jesus sacrificed his life for us. Because of this great love, we should be willing to lay down our lives for one another.*



### DAY 13 – SOCIAL JUSTICE

**For diversity and equality. For an end to human trafficking, food insecurities, and poverty.**

*// Mic. 6-8 No, O people, the Lord has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.*



### DAY 14 – FOLLOW JESUS

**That I would be with Jesus daily, become like Jesus, and do the things Jesus did. Those who don't know Jesus will come to know Him personally.**

*// John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.*
