### **OVERVIEW**

#### How the Gospel Builds a Healthy Multi-Ethnic Family

By the time we get to the fourth chapter of Galatians, we've reached the climax of everything that Paul has said so far. In fact, we have reached the climax of the Gospel. Sinclair Ferguson wrote, "The notion that we are the children of God, His own sons and daughters, is the mainspring of Christian living. Our sonship to God is the apex of creation and the goal of redemption." If we want to understand who a Christian is, and why being a Christian is a privilege, we need to appreciate divine adoption.

"But when the right time came, God sent his Son, born of a woman, subject to the law. God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children. And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father.""
