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WEEKLY APPLICATION

TAKEAWAY: Social sexuality and genital sexuality are different aspects of our sexuality that need to be understood separately. HEAD CHANGE: The true desire of our souls is to be fully known and loved, not just physical sex.

HEART CHANGE: Sexual sin is not worse than other sin, but it is different.

LIFE CHANGE: The church is called to build deep wells of water—environments of fulfillment and acceptance—rather than erecting barriers.
